

## SCHOOL UNIFORM DRESS CODE

### BOYS

#### Boys' Slack (Gr. 1-8)

- \*Navy Blue Dress Slacks (Gr. 1-8)
  - \*Khaki Dress Slacks (Gr. 6-8)
- No cargo pants, top stitching, exterior pockets, rivets, decorations, etc.

#### Walking shorts (navy/white) (khaki 6-8)

May be worn from the first day of school to Sept. 30 and after Spring Break till the last day of school. No shorter than three inches above the knee.

#### Boys' Shirt

- \*Solid color, light blue or white long or short sleeves with collar, a standard dress shirt or knit polo. (Gr. 1-8)
  - \*Navy knit polo (Gr. 6-8)
- (Shirts are worn tucked in except at lunch/recess)

#### Boys' Sweaters/Sweatshirts

White/Navy Blue Sweater  
Pullover/Button Down Sweater  
Grey/Blue with School Emblem Sweatshirt (6-8)  
Light Blue with School Emblem Sweatshirt (1-5)

#### **No hooded sweatshirts in the classroom**

#### Jewelry/Accessories

- Watches, Necklaces with Cross
- One bracelet and/or ring

#### Shoes

- Tennis shoes or walking shoes preferred – neutral color with closed toe
- All Sandals must be worn with socks
- \*No flip flops or athletic sandals at anytime

**Make-up** – no make-up, nail polish, blush, lipstick, lip gloss at anytime

**Earrings** – Posts only

**Hair** - Hair should be neatly groomed and of a natural color no feathers or similar hair extensions. For boys, hair must be cut above the eyebrows and shirt collar.

### GIRLS

#### Girls' Slack

- Blue Uniform Plaid (Gr. 1-5)
  - \*Navy Blue Dress Slacks (Gr. 1-8)
  - \*Khaki Dress Slacks (Gr. 6-8)
- No cargo pants, top stitching, exterior pockets, rivets, decorations, etc.

#### Walking Shorts/Capri (navy/white) (khaki 6-8)

May be worn from the first day of school till Sept. 30 and after Spring Break till the last day of school. No shorter than three inches above the knee.

#### Girl's Shirt

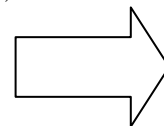
- \*Solid color, light blue or white sleeve polo shirt or uniform blouse.
  - \*Navy knit polo (Gr. 6-8)
- (Shirts are worn tucked in except at lunch/recess.)

#### Girls' Sweaters/Sweatshirts

White/Navy Blue Sweater  
Pullover/Button Down Sweater  
Grey/Blue with School Emblem Sweatshirt (1-8)  
Light Blue with School Emblem (1-8)

#### Girls' skirt/split skirt/Jumper

- Blue uniform plaid -no more than 3 inches above the knee (Gr. 1-5)
- Navy Blue – no shorter than 3 inches above the knee (Gr. 6-8)
- \*Khaki –no shorter than 3 inches above the knee (Gr. 6-8)



## NON – UNIFORM DRESS CODE

There will be only two types of non-uniform days recognized at Assumption School.

### Dress Up Days (no jeans)

### Jean Days

The following are the guidelines which are to be followed for these days. Failure to comply will result in the loss of the next scheduled non-uniform day. Repeated failure to comply with these rules will result in additional consequences.

**Hats** – Are not to be worn in school or classrooms at anytime

**Hair** – No unnatural coloring (i.e. bright pink, red, blue, etc.) – Except when designated

**Earrings** – Are okay to wear

**Jewelry** – One rubberized bracelet similar to “Live Strong”  
Watches, necklace with cross

**Make-Up** – No make-up, blush, lip gloss, nail polish at anytime

### **Shirts**

- No V-neck or scoop necks unless shirt worn underneath
- Printed T’s – positive messages only or neutral – no references to alcohol, tobacco, etc.
- No midriffs showing

### **Shoes**

- No flip flops or athletic sandals at anytime
- All sandals must be worn with socks

### **Shorts**

- Can be worn the month of September and after Spring Break
- No low rise
- Length – no shorter than 3 inches above the knee

**Capri** – Same time frame as shorts

**Skirts** – Length – no shorter than 3 inches above the knee
